## Student Recruitment Guide

### Enrollment Capacity

### Admission Requirements

1. Applicants must be 18 years old or above at the time of application.
  2. High school graduate or higher.
  3. Japanese language proficiency equivalent to JLPT N3 or above.
  4. Those who wish to study caregiving and nursing knowledge and skills and work in Japan as a Certified Nursing Care Professional (Kaigo Fukushishi).
- Preference will be given to applicants with experience in hospitals or nursing care facilities, and graduates of nursing/caregiving schools.
  - Applicants who have previously visited Japan should consult in advance.

### Required Documents

1. Application Form (submitted at the interview application stage)
2. Statement of Purpose for Study Abroad
3. Identification Documents and Passport
4. Japanese Language Proficiency Certificate
5. Japanese Language Study Certificate
6. Graduation Certificate of Highest Education
7. Documents Certifying Family Composition
8. Employment Certificate (for employed applicants)
9. Technical Intern Training Completion Certificate (for former trainees)
10. Certificate Related to Caregiving Studies
11. Any Other Documents Required by the School

### School Fees

- Entrance examination fee, Admission fee, School fee, and other fees may be covered through a loan system (interest-free; repayment required after graduation under specified conditions).
- Scholarships are available through organizations affiliated with the Nara Higashi Hospital Group (repayment required after employment; exemption may apply under certain conditions).
- Students advancing to a caregiver training school in Nara Prefecture may apply for a Nara Prefecture Scholarship: ¥16,000 × 12 months · Repayment exempted if the graduate works in caregiving within Nara Prefecture for five years.
- Self-funded enrollment is also available.
